In the event of a heat wave, we will ensure that children do not overheat by using the overhead fans to cool the hall.

All children will be kept out of extreme heat and kept hydrated by supplying plenty of drinking water.

Outside play will be first thing when there is plenty of shade and all the children **should** provide a sunhat. (Bare shoulders will be covered).

Sun lotion should be applied at home before coming to school, but can be reapplied by Kindergarten staff if supplied by Parent/Carer in a named container.
